

VERDICT FORM A

We, the jury, find for the Plaintiffs and against Cornelius Ezeagu.

We further find that Cornelius Ezeagu was the apparent agent of Yellow Cab Affiliation, Inc.

First: Without taking into consideration the question of reduction of damages due to the negligence of Marc Jacobs, we find that the total amount of damages suffered by Marc Jacobs as a proximate result of the occurrence is \$ 24,987,831, itemized as follows:

The present cash value of the reasonable expenses of medical care, treatment and services reasonably certain to be received in the future	\$ <u>50,000</u>

MARC JACOBS' TOTAL DAMAGES:	\$ <u>24,987,831</u>

We assess Deborah Jacobs' damages in the sum of \$ 4,500,000 for the reasonable value of the society, companionship and sexual relationship with her husband of

which she has been deprived and the society, companionship and sexual relationship with her husband of which she is reasonably certain to be deprived in the future.

DEBORAH JACOBS' TOTAL DAMAGES: \$ 4,500,000

Second: Assuming that 100% represents the total combined negligence of all persons whose negligence proximately contributed to the plaintiffs' damages, including Marc Jacobs and Cornelius Ezeagu, we find that the percentage of such negligence attributable solely to Marc Jacobs is 12 percent (%).

Third: After reducing the total damages sustained by Marc Jacobs by the percentage of negligence attributable solely to Marc Jacobs, we assess Marc Jacobs' recoverable damages in the sum of \$ 21,989,291.

Fourth: After reducing the total damages sustained by Deborah Jacobs by the percentage of negligence attributable solely to Marc Jacobs, we assess Deborah Jacobs' recoverable damages in the sum of \$ 3,460,000.
